E-mail Account in Microsoft Outlook

This tutorial shows you how to set up Microsoft Outlook to work with your e-mail account. This tutorial focuses on setting up Microsoft Outlook 2003, but these settings are similar in other versions of Microsoft Outlook. You can set up previous versions of Microsoft Outlook by using the settings in this tutorial.

To Set Up Your E-mail Account in Microsoft Outlook

2. On the E-mail Accounts wizard window, select "Add a new e-mail account" and click Next.



3. For your server type, select "POP3" and click Next.

4. On the Internet E-mail Settings (POP3) window, enter your information as follows:

Your Name

Enter your first and last name.

E-mail Address

Enter your e-mail address.

User Name

Enter your e-mail address, again.

Password

Enter the password you set up for your e-mail account.

Incoming mail server (POP3)

Enter mail.yourdomainname.com or .net or .org for your incoming mail server.

Outgoing mail server (SMTP)

Enter mail.yourdomainname.com or .net or .org for your outgoing mail server. Please note that some internet service providers will only allow you to use their SMTP server. If this is the case please use the

instructions from your provider to configure the SMTP Settings and Authentication. The Instructions for the SMTP server below are specifically for the SMTP Server details provided by Epictoolbox.

Click "More Settings."

NOTE: "mail.yourdomainname.com" is an example, please replace the domain name with your own. both SMTP and POP server addresses are the same.

- 6. Select "My outgoing server (SMTP) requires authentication."

7. Select "Use same settings as my incoming mail server".
